NO ONLINE PROGRAM

IN-PERSON PROGRAM

MASK-OPTIONAL

Our current plan is for EPIC to be mask-optional this year for kids and volunteers. However, we will continue to monitor the situation and change to masks-required if we feel that becomes necessary. If at any point we begin to require masks and you no longer want your child to participate because of that, we will fully refund your registration fee.

PROGRAM LENGTH

The program will now be 90 minutes long and run from 6:30PM-8:00PM on Wednesdays from September 15th through April 27th at the Aurora, DeKalb and St.Charles campuses. More details on breaks can be found on our campus-specific theme calendar.

CHECK-IN

Nametags will no longer be pre-printed. Instead, you can visit an open check-in station when you arrive to receive your child's name tag and your pickup tag for the night.
