## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

- 1. Describe a time when something or someone did not turn out to be as good as you had expected.
- 2. Read Luke 24:13-21. Why were the two travelers on the road to Emmaus disillusioned with Jesus? Have you ever been disappointed by God? Explain.
- 3. Read Luke 24:36-43. Note all the expressions in these verses that point to the fact that Jesus' resurrection was physical. Read I Corinthians 15:12-19. Why does the apostle Paul say that it is important that Jesus himself is alive (and not merely his memory or teachings)?
- 4. What are some pieces of evidence (cite Holly Ordway's story from the sermon) that Jesus rose from the dead?
- 5. Read Revelation 3:20. What was the significance of Jesus eating a piece of fish in Luke 24 (i.e. what did sharing a meal indicate in the ancient world--and still today)? Why is the church called (in I Corinthians 12:27 and elsewhere) the body of Christ? What are some of the differences between watching a CCC weekend service online and attending it in person?
- Read Luke 24:44-46. How do the following Old Testament texts point to Jesus' death on the cross? Genesis 3:14, 15. Leviticus 17:11 (cp with Hebrews 9:13, 14). Isaiah 53:4-6. Psalm 22:1, 16-18. Why did Jesus have to die?
- 7. Read Acts 2:22-24. Was God caught by surprise by Jesus' death? Explain. What does Romans 8:28 teach about the hardships in your life?
- 8. Read Luke 24:47-49. What mission did Jesus give his followers? What is the power that he refers to in v.49? (See Acts 1:8.) How would a focus on this mission help you face the potentially disillusioning experiences (big and small) in your life?
