DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

- 1 . If you were in a new city, would you rather find something familiar to eat or something you've never had? Would you rather be in an unfamiliar city without a phone or without a wallet?
- 2 . Have everyone open up Acts 17:16-34. As you read it out loud, have everyone underline, circle, or jot down observations. Go around your group and share a few things you noticed.
- 3 . Look at Acts 17:16-34. Identify the places where the culture of Athens was idolatrous. Identify the places where the culture had some insight. Identify the places where the culture was ignorant of the truth. How did Paul use these things to engage people in conversation?
- 4 . Read Acts 17:24-28. As a group, identify as many truths about God as you can. Why do you think Paul chose those attributes of God to mention?
- 5 . What are some of the ways people make up their own ideas about God?
- 6 . What do you do to make sure your ideas about God are true and not just something you came up with or picked up somewhere?
- 7 . Look at Acts 17:32-34. Which of these reactions do you most encounter when you talk to people about Jesus? What other reactions do you get?
- 8 . Are you doing Bible Savvy? If not, how are you making sure you are in God's Word daily?

Using the attributes of God you identified in this passage, spend time praying those words back to God, praising who God is and honoring God's character. mind, receive it open-handedly. Then, ask God to help you give generously out of what you have received. As you go through the next week, try to consciously envision living open-handedly with all you have received from God.
