DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

1. What is the most interesting or unusual fruit you've ever tried? What is your favorite fruit?
2. According to Galatians 5:13-14, what are we supposed to use our freedom to do? How is that different from the idea of freedom in our culture?
3. According to Galatians 5:16-17, what is the obstacle to true freedom? What are some of the ways this shows up in your own life?
4. How did Clayton define "the flesh" in his sermon?
5. How does misused freedom lead to the things described in Galatians 5:19-21? How have you seen the effects of misused freedom in your life?
6. Why do you think Paul uses the image of "fruit" in Galatians 5:22?
7. Read through Galatians 5:22-23. Have each person share which one of these qualities would make the most difference in their own life.
8. Why and how would people who look like this (Galatians 5:22-23) turn the world upside down?
9. What will you do to "keep in step with the Spirit" (Galatians 5:25) this week?

PRAYER PROMPT: Fruit of the Spirit. Read through the fruit of the Spirit again in Galatians 5:22-23. Spend 2 minutes praying over which one of those you see best reflected in your life, and ask the Spirit to show you how you can use it to bless others this week. Now spend 2 minutes praying over the one you'd like to grow in, and pray for the Spirit to help you grow in that area in the coming week.
