## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

- 1. When did you first start going to church? What was that like for you?
- 2. What does it make you think and/or feel when you hear the statistic that if trends continue 40 out of every 100 church buildings will no longer be churches by 2040?
- 3. Read Neh 2:11-16. What kinds of things in your life have you spent considerable time researching or planning for? Why did you do that?
- 4. Read Neh 2:1-9. What do you imagine Nehemiah was thinking and feeling as he asked the king for such crazy-big things? What causes people to do things outside of their comfort zone?
- 5. In the sermon, Pastor Eric mentioned that not everyone's "crazy-big" gift is the same. What did he mean by that, and why does it matter? (Hint- check out Mark 12:41-44)
- 6. For this Places Need Churches campaign, how are we defining "crazy-big"? How would you describe this to someone else?
- 7. Based on what was shared in the sermon, Matthew 6:24 and Mark 4:18-19, react to this statement: Money is completely neutral.
