**Icebreaker:** Who are the two or three people who had the greatest impact on your decision to surrender your life to Christ? Explain their role.

**Icebreaker 2:** Pastor Jim mentioned in his sermon that Christ Community's Legacy Value of Evangelism accounts for the excitement that people experience at our church. Why do you think that's the case?

1. What's the connection between the story in II Kings 7:3, 4 and the words of the apostle Paul in Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:1? Why do our sins result in death? What were the signs of spiritual death in your life before you surrendered to Christ?

2. Read II Corinthians 5:10, 11. What motivation for evangelism does Paul allude to in these verses? What does it mean to evangelize? Why does it require words?

3. What do you think keeps people from recognizing the danger of their spiritual condition without Christ? What might you pray for those you know in this condition?

4. What's the connection between the story in II Kings 7:5-8 and the words of I Peter 3:18, Ephesians 1:7, 8, and 2:6-8? How does Jesus' death on the cross rescue us from death? Describe some of the spiritual riches you have experienced since surrendering your life to Christ.

5. Read II Kings 7:9-11. What do the lepers conclude that they are doing wrong? Why would that be wrong? How does this part of the story relate to evangelism?

6. Who have you not shared the Good News with that you should share the Good News with? What's held you back? What might you learn from the lepers that would propel you forward?

7. Describe Christ Community's 3-pronged approach to evangelism: attractional; missional; relational. What makes each one effective? Which of the 3 has been your strongest? Your weakest? 8. Who might you invite to Christ Community in 2025? Why did that person come to mind? What's your next step?

9. Go to ccclife.org/communityimpact and survey our local partners. Which of these would interest you, and why? What is your next step?

10. Read Matthew 9:10-12. What could you learn from Jesus' example? Why is this behavior so important? How might you put it into practice?
