### FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

2. Share your immediate emotional reaction to this statement: God knows everything about you.
3. Do you ever feel the pressure to be all-knowing or everywhere? If so, how does this show up in your life and how does it affect you?
4. Have someone read aloud Psalm 139—the entire Psalm. After it is read, each person in the group shares one thing that strikes them as personally meaningful.
5. Eric had two stools on the stage. He also shared a picture and a story about a pier. How do these stools and the pier relate to each other? Why and how does this matter for our lives?
6. Which application is more pertinent to your life right now: God is with you on the hard days, or God wants to lead you on the normal days? Explain.
7. In what ways does God's omnipresence and omniscience make him the best leader for our lives?
8. Is there another application that you are taking away from this sermon and discussion that you'd like to share with the group?
